REPORT

REMEDIAL COACHING PROGRAM 2022-2023 FOR SLOW LEARNERS

The Remedial coaching program for the academic year 2022-23 was implemented to support identified weak learners, aligning with the IQAC policy and facilitated by the admission committee of the college. The primary objective was to enhance the performance of struggling students across various subjects, offering targeted teaching support to improve subject knowledge, academic skills, and linguistic proficiency. The program also provided an opportunity for faculties to mentor students who had not successfully cleared one or more papers in previous semesters, alongside their current semester commitments.

The majority of departments efficiently executed the remedial coaching program within the stipulated time frame, showcasing a commitment to academic support for struggling students. Well-organized classes, personalized training and repeated practice sessions are the key components of the remedial coaching program.

FY BCOM

Remedial sessions for FY BCOM were conducted on three Wednesdays of a month for Sem I and Sem II.

Following subjects were decided to be allotted for remedial sessions in Sem I.

- FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT & ACCOUNTANCY I
- BUSINESS ECONOMICS I
- MATHEMATICAL TECHNIQUES I

Following subjects were decided to be allotted for remedial sessions in Sem II.

- FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT & ACCOUNTANCY II
- BUSINESS ECONOMICS II
- MATHEMATICAL TECHNIQUES

Total of 167 students were identified as slow learners in FY BCOM. The majority of students attended the remedial lectures and solved their queries.

Personalized attention in Accountancy focused on understanding the subject's golden rules. Tailored sessions tried to solve fundamental principles. Practice sums reinforced theoretical knowledge, emphasizing practical effects of debit and credit. This approach aims to enhance students' proficiency and confidence in learning Accountancy, with continuous feedback guiding students for sustained academic success.

The Economics faculty provided essential guidance to students, covering fundamental concepts and instructing on the creation of graphs and diagrams for topics such as demand-supply, equilibrium, and market structures. This hands-on approach aimed to induce a deeper understanding of key economic principles.

Mathematics doubt clearing sessions emphasized core concepts like operations, BODMAS rule, and tables, with practical assignments from university question papers. Regular practice sums enhanced problem-solving skills and guided students through challenging sums. Sessions also covered advanced topics like word problems, derivatives, shares, simple and compound interest and mutual funds. Continuous reinforcement via assignments aimed to solidify theoretical understanding. Counseling sessions addressed exam prep and stress management, showcasing a holistic approach to student well-being and academic success.

SY BCOM

Remedial sessions for SY BCOM were conducted every Wednesdays for Sem III and Sem IV.

Following subjects were decided to be allotted for remedial sessions in Sem III.

- BUSINESS LAW I
- ACCOUNTANCY AND FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT III
- INTRODUCTION TO MANAGEMENT ACCOUNTING
- BUSINESS ECONOMICS III

Following subjects were decided to be allotted for remedial sessions in Sem IV.

- BUSINESS LAW II
- ACCOUNTANCY AND FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT IV
- BUSINESS ECONOMICS

Total of 76 students were identified as slow learners in SY BCOM considering the average CGPA of Sem1 and Sem II. Remedial lectures were conducted by respective faculties and doubts clearing sessions were arranged in classrooms.

In Management Accounting, students were taught how to calculate and interpret ratios through practical exercises in class. Faculty members provided personalized sessions to address individual doubts, ensuring a comprehensive understanding.

For Accountancy, specialized sessions were conducted in fundamentals of preparing final accounts, particularly in scenarios involving partner's admission, retirement, or death, basics in entries related to redemption of preference shares and debentures and classification of expenses. This approach aimed to strengthen intricate accounting concepts among students.

The Economics faculty focused on imparting a solid foundation in key economic principles such as money, price, inflation, and macroeconomics, difference between public finance and public revenue. Sums and graphs were employed as teaching tools, allowing students to practice and apply theoretical knowledge.

In Business Law, challenging terms were taught through detailed explanations, notes, and case studies. Topics such as the Indian Contract Act, Law of Indemnity, Contract of Guarantee, Negotiable Instruments, and Sale of Goods Act, Indian Company Law, IPR, LLP etc. were thoroughly explained to the students. To assess understanding and enhance writing skills, students were encouraged to solve previous years' question papers

26 students attended the coaching program in Sem V and Sem VI. Professors guided and counselled the students on various issues faced by the students.

Remedial sessions for students were conducted for Financial Accounting subject in preparing final accounts. Students were made to understand the basics of buyback of shares and its procedures. Sums for practice were given to students on company accounts, implementing the accounting effects which is to be given in case of amalgamation, absorption and external reconstruction. Also imparted knowledge about agreements between company and underwriters along with their workings. Sums for practice were given to students on company accounts.

The economics faculty guided the students with basic concepts of macroeconomics, structure, growth and reforms in financial markets, trade and gains from international trade, emphasis was given to them on ways to correct balance of payment, disequilibrium, and the recent developments in WTO.

Detailed explanations to students about various terms were given in the subject Export Marketing. Students were introduced to various INCO terms of export marketing, risk and problems, FTP, various incentives and assistance available to Indian exporters. Various factors influencing distribution channels, components of logistics and sales promotion techniques used in Export marketing. Various export registration procedures, shipping and custom stage formalities and the importance of documentation for exporting work were explained. Previous years' question papers were solved in lectures.
